SUBJECT: Release of Actionable Medical Information Policy

1. Reference. OTSG/MEDCOM Policy Memo 05-018, Release of Actionable Medical Information.
2. The process established in the Release of Actionable Medical Information (AMI) policy memo is a valuable tool in the fight to deny the enemy medical information. It balances the protection of sensitive information while still promoting and sharing high-quality AMEDD research and analysis. MEDCOM successfully implemented this policy on 2 Dec 05. I want to thank all commands for their hard work and continued vigilance to ensure all appropriate material is reviewed IAW the AMI policy.
3. One of the lessons learned is the need for timely submission of material. Authors must submit materials with enough lead time for the reviewers to properly perform their assessment. Authors requesting urgent evaluations are often not providing reviewers enough time to properly assess the material. Commanders are required to continue to educate staff and evaluate internal processes to ensure an efficient and effective AMI review system.
